

Colorado's kindergarten MMR (measles, mumps, rubella) vaccination rate is the **lowest in the U.S. at 87.4%** for the 2018-19 school year. This numb..






Colorado is **one of only 15 states** in the U.S. that allow personal belief exemptions for all school-required vaccines.

Data made possible through HB14-1288 and subsequent rulemaking which requires schools and licensed child care centers to annually report immunization and exemption rates to the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE).


#### How are schools in this district doing?

Of the **45** schools in this district, **44.4%** achieve recommended vaccination levels that help ensure community immunity\* for all school required vaccines.

This means that **8,162** students in this district attend a school that does not achieve high protection from the diseases prevented by school-required vaccines.

#### How many students might be excluded in the case of a measles outbreak?

Out of the **19,396** students in this district, **928** might be at risk of exclusion from school in the instance of a measles outbreak because they either have an exemption to the MMR vaccine on file or do not have a record of MMR vaccination.



### Kindergarten MMR Vaccination Rates by School (of schools with Kindergarten)

A vaccination level of 95% , as indicated by the green line, is needed to provide community immunity\* against measles.

\* **Community Immunity** is achieved when enough people in the community - roughly 95% for a disease like measles - are vaccinated to protect against the spread of disease. Maintaing high vaccine coverage is especially important for those who cannot be vaccinated for medial reasons or those too young to recieve vaccines.
