Colorado kids 5 to 11 and the COVID-19 vaccine: WHAT PARENTS NEED TO KNOW



Medical experts recommend that everyone 5 years and older get the **COVID-19 vaccine**

These vaccines are free and require no health insurance or identification



The kids' vaccine is 90% effective in preventing infection and 100% effective at preventing severe disease and death

More than 3,100 children age 5 to 11 safely received the vaccine in clinical trials with no severe side effects



Millions of 12to 17-year-olds have already safelv been vaccinated

The vaccine dose recommended for children is just one third of the vaccine dose given to people 12 and older

The science behind mRNA COVID-19 vaccines is not new; scientists have been studying it for decades



About 1 in 4 cases of COVID-19 in the U.S. are among those ages 17 and younger

COVID-19 can put kids at risk of severe illness and even death; the vaccine is the best protection we can offer kids against it



Here's what parents should expect:



Vaccination requires two shots about three weeks apart

Mild side effects such as headache, fatique or lowarade fever show your child's body is mounting an immune response, which is good



Other vaccines, such as the flu vaccine, can be given at the same time as the COVID-19 vaccine

Making sure your child is vaccinated against COVID-19 will allow them to return to normal childhood activities
