The Alliance for HPV Free Colorado (Alliance) is a collaborative project funded by the Cancer Cardiovascular and Chronic Pulmonary Disease Grants Program working to implement a multidisciplinary, socioecological approach that results in a sustainable increase in completion of the vaccine series for 9-17-year-old.

The HPV vaccination prevents six types of HPV-related cancers
